IDs Description:

name = It is the product name that will show in Product List

icon = It's thumb Photo for products menu, size should be 160x162 Pixel **and it should be prepared from your first product colour.**



printAreaID = define which print Area format is good for this product

photoID = define that photo has two side or only one side [Double - Single]

sizeID = 1 for products with size and 0 for product without size

price = shows the product price

currency = shows the currency sign in shop

or here a product setting for a Cap in two colours:
